**RESOLUTION FROM THE THIRD MEETING OF THE ISO IEC UN/ECE
COORDINATING COMMITTEE
Friday, 1 May 1998, Miami**

Resolution 98/1 : MoU Approval

The MoU Coordinating Committee resolves to accept the revision to the MoU as per document MoU/CC/98 N030 and requests each standardization organization to approve it and take the necessary actions for the immediate launch of the MoU Management Group.

Resolution 98/2 : MoU Approval

The MoU Coordinating Committee invites CALS International and the NATO CALS Organisation to sign up as participating international user groups in the MoU as per document MoU/CC/98 N030.

Resolution 98/3 : Request for ITU-T participation

The MoU Coordinating Committee resolves to request ITU-T to participate in the MoU as a Standardization Organization because of the increasing number of ITU work items relevant to Electronic Business.

Resolution 98/4 : Call for members

The MoU/CC resolves that in accordance with MoU/CC/98 N030 Annex B, each standardization organization and participating international user group should designate its participants in the MoU Management Group (MoU/MG).

The names should be communicated to the MoU/MG secretariat.

Resolution 98/5 : Contact points for the MoU/MG

The MoU/CC resolves that in accordance with MoU/CC/98 N030 Annex B, each standardization organization and participating international user group should designate a primary contact to address issues arising between meetings.

The names should be communicated to the MoU/MG secretariat.

Resolution 98/6 : MoU/CC Disbandment

The MoU Coordinating Committee resolves accordingly to disband itself immediately on acceptance of the revised MoU.

Resolution 98/7 : ISO/TC154 resolution 140

The MoU Coordinating Committee requests ISO/TC154 to withdraw its resolution 140, since the chairman will be available.

Resolution 98/8 : ISO/TC154 resolution 145

The MoU Coordinating Committee requests the MoU Management Group to address the issue raised in ISO/TC154 resolution 145.

Resolution 98/9 : ISO/TC154 resolution 139

The MoU Coordinating Committee requests ISO TC154 to ensure that the adhoc group created under its resolution 139 submits its conclusions and recommendations to the JSWG.

Resolution 98/10 : ISO/TC184

The MoU Coordinating Committee requests TC184 to ensure that the European project on PBDH is integrated with the joint STEP/EDIFACT activities.
