### **Resolution WG 1/11: New Project Proposal on Identification, Mapping and IT-enablement of Existing Standards for Widely Used Encodeable Value Domains (SC 32 N0272)**

SC 32/WG 1 requests close liaison with SC 32/WG 2 on this New Project Proposal due to its close linkage with Semantic Components contained in the work of WG 1 on Business Agreement Semantic Descriptive Techniques.

### **Resolution WG 1/12: Use of Electronic Means for Document Editing and Communication**

SC 32/WG 1 accepts the offer of the Standards Council of Canada to make available SCC Forum as a resource in support of the secretariat to use the electronic facility.
