**Abstract:** We present information needed by delegates attending WG 3 meetings in Warwick, England, 3-14 July, 2000.

## 1. Introduction

It is planned to hold an interim meeting of ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 32/WG 3 and certain ballot resolution meetings in Warwick, England, during the two week period 3-14 July, 2000.

The location for these meetings is the premises of IBM United Kingdom Limited in Warwick. I, Hugh Darwen, and my IBM colleague Gill Dawson will be your hosts. (We are also hosting a meeting of ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 32/WG 4 during the previous week, 26-30 June.)

Gill will answer questions about the arrangements. Contact me if you have any requirements that we appear not to be addressing in these arrangements.

### 2.2 Registration

Every delegate *must* register by sending an e-mail to Gill. Those who wish to take advantage of Gill's hotel arrangements are strongly recommended to do so by **24 April, 2000**. If you are making your own arrangements for accommodation, you must still register with Gill but need not do so until a few days before your arrival.

Please supply the following information:

- Your name and affiliation (as you wish them appear on your badge)
- The meetings (WG 3 and/or WG 4) you plan to attend.
- The dates, if any, of your intended stay at the recommended hotel.

No fees are being levied in connection with these meetings.

### 2.3 Hotel Information

The recommended hotel is **Thistle Hotel, Stratford-upon-Avon**, about 8 miles from Warwick. Fifteen rooms with twin beds have been reserved in Gill Dawson's name for the WG 3 meeting (twelve for the WG 4 meeting), from the Saturday before the start of the meeting until the Friday on which the meeting ends.

A special price of £65 per night, bed and breakfast, has been negotiated with the hotel. This price assumes single occupancy—a surcharge of £20 per night applies if you are accompanied.

If you request one of these rooms when you send your registration e-mail to Gill, she will send you a confirmation number. You will not need to contact the hotel directly.

Any rooms not taken by 24 April, 2000, will cease to be reserved and the special price may not be applicable after that date. The hotel expects to be fully occupied during the week beginning 3 July on account of a certain big event that is being held in the vicinity at that time.

The Thistle Hotel is situated just the other side of the road from the famous **Royal Shakespeare Theatre** in Stratford, whose other two theatres are just a short walk from there.

**2.4 Travel to England**

The nearest international airport is Birmingham (BHX). The taxi ride from there to Warwick or Stratford takes about 20 minutes.

Heathrow airport, London (LHR) is about 90 miles south-east of Warwick. To drive from there to Warwick or Stratford, take the M4 motorway west, then the M25 north, then the M40 north. Leave the M40 at junction 15, which is the second Warwick exit, signposted to Stratford and Warwick. Junction 15 consists of a large roundabout forming a bridge over the motorway, controlled by traffic lights. The second exit off this roundabout is the A46 to Stratford and the fourth exit is the A46 in the other direction, for Warwick. This roundabout is the one referred to in the next section.

**2.5 IBM Warwick**

Instructions for getting to IBM Warwick are at <http://www.ibm.com/uk/locations> (click on Warwick). If you come by car from Stratford, the first paragraph, headed *From M40 (south/London via Oxford) Warwick/Stratford*, is applicable but you do not actually join the M40. Instead, you leave Stratford on the A46 and cross over the M40 at a huge roundabout controlled by traffic lights about 2 miles (3.2 km) before the A4177 exit referred to in the instructions.

There is a small visitors' car park near the main entrance and there are several large car parks for employees. Parking typically gets extremely difficult after 9:00am, so early arrival is advised.

Report at main reception for your badge and directions to the meeting room, which is expected to be *The Executive Briefing Room*.
