The Editing Meeting completed its business on the 11th of May 2001.

The SQL CD Editing Meeting met between 30th April 2001 and 11th May 2001 in Perth, Australia. Attendance at the SQL Parts 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 10 and 11 CD Editing Meeting consisted of 19 representatives from 8 countries: Australia (3), Canada (3), Germany (2), Japan (3), Netherlands (1), Sweden (1), UK (2), USA (4).

Stephen Cannan (Netherlands) and Jim Melton (USA) conducted the meeting in their capacities as WG3 Convenor and SQL3 Editor, respectively.

The SQL CD Editing Meeting was charged with responding to the CD ballot comments and producing revised text for publication. All of the P-Member bodies voting no on any part attended the Editing Meeting, as did the one O-Member body that expressed a negative opinion.

The SQL CD Editing Meeting considered 660 Ballot Comments from the SQL CD Ballots. The meeting was able to completely resolve all but 167 comments, including several dozen additional problems found during the editing process.

The Editing Meeting believes that the most effective way to complete the resolution of the remaining comments is to schedule 2 continuation editing meetings. The first such meeting would be an electronic meeting run, using facilities provided by the Standards Council of Canada, over an extended period in July and August with 2 decision points at 28th July and 20th August to process as many of the smaller and non-controversial fixes and to expose and discuss the larger or more controversial ones before having a final face-to-face continuation editing meeting co-located with the SC32 meeting in Victoria to complete the work.

The Editor, Jim Melton, plans to have interim text available by Friday 8th June as input to the first meeting and further revised interim text available by Saturday 8th September as input to the second meeting.

A revised Consolidated Ballot Comments document showing resolutions to date is available as WG3:E3B-010 and the minutes of the Perth meeting will be posted as WG3:E3B-001.
