The Editing Meeting completed its business on the 25th of October 2001.

The SQL FCD Editing Meeting met between 17th October 2001 and 25th October 2001 in Victoria, BC, Canada.

Attendance at the SQL Parts 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 10 and 11 CD Editing Meeting consisted of 23 representatives from 7 countries: Brazil (1), Canada (3), Germany (1), Japan (2), Netherlands (1), UK (2), USA (13).

Stephen Cannan (Netherlands) and Jim Melton (USA) conducted the meeting in their capacities as WG3 Convenor and SQL3 Editor, respectively.

The SQL CD Editing Meeting was charged with responding to the FCD ballot comments and producing revised text for publication. All of the P-Member bodies voting no on any part attended the Editing Meeting.

The SQL CD Editing Meeting considered 228 Ballot Comments from the SQL FCD Ballot. The meeting was able to completely resolve all 228, and in addition solved a few additional problems found during the editing process.

The ISO/IEC FCD 9075-13 SQL/JRT Editing Meeting completed its business on the 25th October 2001 with the following resolution which was passed unanimously:

The delegates to the editing meeting recommend to the SC32 Secretariat that the output document produced by the editor be submitted for FDIS ballot, as a new part of ISO/IEC 9075:1999 as soon as possible.

The Editor, Jim Melton, shipped camera-ready copy on December 17th of 2001 to the SC32 Secretariat for the two-month FDIS ballots on this SQL part.

The FCD editing meeting further recommended, following past precedent, that the following documents should comprise its Disposition of Comments Report:
