The Editing Meeting completed its business on the 25th of October 2001.

The SQL CD Editing Meeting met between 19th October 2001 and 25th October 2001 in Victoria, BC, Canada.

Attendance at the SQL Parts 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 10 and 11 CD Editing Meetings consisted of 24 representatives from 9 countries: Australia(3), Brazil (1), Canada (3), Germany (3), Japan (3), Netherlands (1), Sweden (1), UK (3), USA (6).

Stephen Cannan (Netherlands) and Jim Melton (USA) conducted the meeting in their capacities as WG3 Convenor and SQL3 Editor, respectively.

The SQL CD Editing Meeting was charged with responding to the CD ballot comments and producing revised text for publication. All of the P-Member bodies voting no on any part attended the Editing Meeting.

The SQL CD Editing Meeting considered 661 comments resulted from the CD ballot. These comments were distributed between the parts as follows:

Part 1	43
Part 2	425
Part 3	11
Part 4	57
Part 9	57
Part 10	30
Part 11	38

The Editing Meetings managed to resolve all of these 25 of these Ballot Comments. A number of Ballot Comments required that any additional problems discovered during the editing process also be resolved. A number of such comments were discovered and resolved. Of the 25 comments 15 were existing problems and 10 were new problems reported on ballot comments. In addition, 10 problems discovered during the meetings were not solved during the meetings.

At the close of the final meeting there were **35** outstanding known problems with the part under ballot.

Three CD Editing Meetings were held.

The first was in Perth in between the 30th April and the 11th May 2001.

The second was held between the 2nd July and the 24th August 2001 electronically using facilities kindly provided by SCC.

The third was held between 19th October and 25th October at the SC32 meeting in Victoria, BC, Canada.

The last meeting completed its business on the 25th of October 2001 with the following resolution, which was passed unanimously by the National Bodies present:

The Editing Meeting held in Victoria, BC, Canada, between the 19th and the 25th of October 2001 recommend that the output text of this meeting be progressed to FCD ballot as soon as the revised text is available.

The National Bodies felt that the number of outstanding problems was low enough to initiate a ballot at the next level.

The Editor, Jim Melton, shipped camera-ready copy on January 15th of 2002 to the SC32 Secretariat for the four-month FCD ballots on these SQL parts.
