At the Plenary of OMG TC Meeting in Anaheim, US, on 1<sup>st</sup> Feb. 2002, OMG approved those ISO liaison matters, as followed.

- (1) Dr. R.M. Soley, Chair of OMG, took over the role of international liaison to ISO SC32 which was assigned to Mr. Henry Lowe.
- (2) The PAS submission on MOF/XMI is still open and it is expected to be finalized ASAP.  
Dr. Soley will reinitiate the Explanatory Report work in OMG.
- (3) A collaborative work between SC32 and OMG for the metamodel framework standardization, was approved as a part of the new RFP works for MOF2.0 (MOF extensions).
- (4) Mr. Andrew Watson, Vice Chair of OMG, took a volunteer role to make a presentation at the SC32 Open Forum on the topics “Vision of Model Driven Architecture(MDA) and collaboration with ISO activities” at Seoul on 29<sup>th</sup> April.
