This is a combined report document of two interim meetings of SC32/WG1. Corresponding resolutions documents are WG1 N330 (London) and WG1 N352 / SC32 N1603 (Piscataway)

1. General

WG1 has gained more popularity in the last few meetings. Experts from the following NBs have actively participated in the work of WG1:

Canada
China
Finland
Great Britain
Japan
Korea (rep.)
USA

The biggest challenge in participation is that Mr. Hannu Pelkonen will step down from convener's post in July 2007. At the same time Finland will not continue running the WG secretariat. Luckily Mr Paul Levine (USA) has volunteered to act as interim convener of WG1 until a new convener is nominated. Canada's excellent help in document distribution and provision of electronic workspace will also be continued.

- *To send out a request for nominations of candidates for new convener*

2. Work

2.1 Standards development

Main attention in the work of WG1 has been paid to development of multipart standard 15944. The status of parts is as follows:

15944-1	Ready. One corrigendum published
15944-2	Ready
15944-3 (Description techniques)	The project has been reactivated. New CD document is expected to be sent out for ballot in December 2007
15944-4	Currently being balloted as FDIS
15944-5	Currently being balloted as FDIS
15944-6 (Introduction of eBusiness Modelling)	Sent out for 3 rd PDTR ballot in June 2007
15944-7 (Vocabulary)	Sent out for FCD ballot in June 2007
15944-8 (Privacy Requirements)	Acceptance for project split requested. See Resolution 23 of WG1 N330

It has also been decided that WG1 will update and publish new versions of all parts of 15944 plus IS 14662 in order to ensure consistency and integrity of the whole set of standards that have been developed by WG1. The editor of 14662 has already been instructed to update the terminology of the standard.

- *To accept CD ballots of parts 3 and 8 in December 2007*
- *To accept FDIS ballots of Parts 6 and 7 in December 2007*
