Dates and requirement

Target dates: 19 - 30 May 2008

Location: Sydney

(Sydney is the location most likely to attract Australian participation in SC32 meeting, Metadata Openforum and possibly new people to ISO SC32 meetings .. and probably easier for Standards Australia to assist)
(Brisbane, Melbourne (maybe Adelaide) are possibilities if venues are a problem in Sydney)

Meetings (& Metadata Openforum):

1. SC32 Opening and Closing Plenaries,
2. WG meetings. 4 WGs meetings are typically of different lengths (see below)
3. Adhoc meetings to address issues arising from opening plenary and during the course of the meeting,

History

1. Australia last hosted the annual ISO JTC1 SC32 Plenary and associated Working Group meetings 10 years ago in July 1998.
2. We have signalled an intent to host at the 2005 and 2006 SC32 Plenaries. (Resolution 17 in SC32 Documents: 32N1273-SC Resolutions (22-4-2005), 32N1434a - SC32 Final resolutions (31-3-2006)

Meeting Requirements - Dates

The 2 week pattern is typically:(and see table below)

- Week1: - WG3 all week (and all Week2)
 - Metadata Open Forum - 3 days (Mon-Wed)
 - WG2 Thurs, Fri (then all following week)
- Week2: - SC32 Opening Plenary and seminars (Mon morning)
 - SC32 Closing Plenary (Fri)
 - Ad Hocs (Mon, Tues, Wed, Thurs Morn)
 - WG1 - (Mon to Thurs)
 - WG2 - (Mon- Fri)
 - WG3 - (Mon - Fri)

Other Requirements

1. Secretariat Operations Room
2. Broadband wireless Internet connectivity in each meeting room.
3. Computer support - Server and PCs, Printers, ability to connect, upload and download wirelessly from anywhere in the site

Metadata Openforum (see <http://metadataopenforum.org> for 2007 Metatadata Openforum)

Run in conjunction with the SC32 meeting - mostly WG1&2 organised with participants from a range of standards areas.
The 2007 agenda runs over three days with 3 parallel streams on days 2 and 3.

Separately chargeable - based on hosting cost - (ballpark \$500)

Should be of interest to DAMA (Data Administration and Management Association) and ACS (Australian Computer Society)

Expect 100-150 participants

Meeting Fee

It has become common practice for the host of the annual SC32 meeting to charge a meeting fee - typically around US\$400
