Canada

No. The Letter Ballot contains the text "and accept the project subdivision if at least four National Bodies support the subdivision". We believe this is not procedurally correct according to the directives which require the support of five National Bodies.

Japan

No. It is appropriate to develop a standard interface for the MDR exchanging in SC32/WG2. After the standard interface has developed in WG2, it should be a subproject of SQL/MM if there is a necessity of providing this interface on SQL/MM.
