

## ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 32/WG 4 London Meeting Draft Resolutions

Twelve experts representing six National Bodies (Canada, Germany, Japan, Korea, UK, and US) participated the WG 4 meeting.

### **Resolution WG4-1 Title of SQL/MM Part 8**

Based on the joint meeting discussion with WG 2, WG 4 resolved the title of SQL/MM part 8. New title of SQL/MM Part 8 is “Metadata Registry Access (MRA)”.

### **Resolution WG4-2 FCD ballot for SQL/MM Part 3: Spatial**

WG 4 resolved to progress SQL/MM Part 3: Spatial to FCD. WG 4 asks SC 32 Secretariat to conduct an FCD ballot for SQL/MM Part 3: Spatial upon receipt of the revised text.

### **Resolution WG4-3 2<sup>nd</sup> FCD ballot for SQL/MM Part 7: History**

WG 4 resolved to have 2<sup>nd</sup> FCD ballot on SQL/MM Part 7: History. WG 4 asks SC 32 Secretariat to conduct a 2<sup>nd</sup> FCD ballot for SQL/MM Part 7: History upon receipt of the revised text.

### **Resolution WG4-4 Editing Meeting**

WG4 requests SC32 to clarify its interpretation of operating procedures for ballot resolution under the JTC1 directives in the conduct of editing meetings, particularly the facilitation of the progression of documents using separate agendas for tracking and reporting. WG4 feels it is necessary to recognize a separation of the conduct of the resolution of ballot comments for standards progression vis-a-vis working group progression of working draft documents.
