**Request to make “ISO/IEC 9075-1:2010 (E) Information technology - Database languages - SQL – Part 1: Framework (SQL/Framework)” a freely available standard**

1. Since the late 1990`s, ISO has made standards freely available on the World Wide Web providing that certain criteria are met. These criteria are stated in document JTC1 N7604.

One such criteria is Criteria 6 “Reference Models B` which describe frameworks to guide standards development”. This is the case with Part 1 –Framework (SQL/Framework) for the multipart ISO/IEC 9075 standard.

2. Here Canada notes that both SC32/WG1 and WG2 already have standards which are freely available. This enhances widespread awareness and use of their standards (including those which are not freely available). Currently .SC32/WG3 and WG4 do not have a freely available standard pertaining to their “SQL” related standards development activities.
3. Making ISO/IEC 9075-1 Framework a freely available JTC1 publication on the WWW :
  - enhances the awareness and influence of JTC1
  - promotes awareness and understanding of the multipart SQL standard to both standards developers within ISO, IEC and ISO/IEC JTC1 communities as well as standard users and implementers at large, i.e. by having such a document readily and freely available.
- .4. Consequently, Canada is of the opinion that JTC1/SC32 should adopt a resolution at its May, 2010 Kunming Plenary to request ISO/IEC JTC1 to make Part 1: Framework of ISO/IEC 9075 a freely available standard based on the criteria noted above.

Following JTC1/SC32 adopting such a resolution, the JTC1/SC32 Secretariat should be instructed to prepare a SC32 N document for transmittal to JTC1 and for the JTC1/SC32 Chair to present at the 2010 JTC1 Plenary meeting.
